Bedford was one of 12 towns which piloted the independent business-led BID back in 2005 and in 2017 is in its third five-year term. There are over 240 BIDs across the UK which have followed the example set by those early pioneers.

The bottom-line success of BedfordBID is demonstrated in its increase in footfall versus falling visitor numbers in other similar market towns.

This has been achieved through a combination of highly visible Love Bedford branded and high profile sponsored events and promotions, together with multi media advertising including outdoor, printed publications, radio, social media and online - all giving customers a compelling reason to turn to Bedford for a day or evening out.

BedfordBID is firmly in the hands of town centre businesses ranging from national chains to local independents which a wide range of



## Welcome to Bedford

## An Enviable Business Heritage...

Bedford is proud of its rich history as a centre of industry and innovation. During the 19th century, the area became the heart of brickmaking in the UK and the River Great Ouse was a major route for trade and travel. In the 20th century, the area built a reputation for innovative engineering.

As well as pioneering new techniques for diesel and aero engines, the area produced components for prestige projects such as the Titanic. The famous R100 and R101 airships were also built at Cardington and this reputation for innovation and technology in the area continues today.

## A Dynamic Business Community...

Today, the area has a diverse and vibrant business community. Important existing and emerging sectors include electronics, research & development, automotive, logistics and business services, with a significant manufacturing base also growing.



High profile companies in the area include Unilever, 3M, Autoglass and Fujifilm. The business environment is highly competitive and there are ample opportunities for entrepreneurs to network, share ideas, access support, and make their voice heard. The area is seen as a first class business location and rapidly emerging market, which is reflected in business optimism and sustained investment in the area.

## Location

Bedford Borough is located around 50 miles north of London. The area has a population of 166,300 (mid-year estimate 2015) and covers approximately 117,723 acres. Bedford and Kempston are the main urban areas whilst much of the area has a pleasant rural feel, with rural parishes that help make the area so appealing for both living and working.

## Infrastructure

One of the area's major advantages is the combination of its central location and excellent connectivity to the rest of the UK and the world.





The M1 and A1 both run through the area, as do two major rail routes linking London, cities in the North and several international airports.

For international travel, London Luton Airport is within a short drive or rail journey from the area and London Stansted can be reached within the hour. Both airports offer an extensive range of European destinations.

With ambitious growth targets for the area, several significant improvements have recently taken place. These include the dualling of the A421 link road between the A1 and the M1 and the completion of the Western Bypass, which is enhancing the benefits already afforded by the A421 bypass. With the Eurostar station at St Pancras, travel by rail from the area to Paris or Brussels can be done in just over 3 hours!







## Key Business Locations

High quality business parks and estates offer accommodation to suit almost every commercial need. Prime examples include Priory Business Park, Elms & Viking Industrial Estate and Marsh Leys. In addition to these flagship sites, there is a range of office space in both town centre and rural locations. ## People

The level of professionally, technically and managerially qualified people is far greater than the national average. Combined with the area's diverse sectoral base, this provides a highly skilled, adaptable and motivated workforce, ideal for companies looking to expand or to develop into new areas. The area's population is set to grow dramatically in the next few years with around 30,000 new homes earmarked by 2021. This will increase the size and skill base of the labour force even further.



Educational attainment rates are excellent across the spectrum of the area's schools, including world renowned Harpur Trust Schools. The presence of Cranfield and Bedfordshire Universities in the area mean a high quality of degree level and post graduate education.



# IT'S ALL HAPPENING IN 2017!


Gallagher Estates will complete the final residential elements of Lakeview Village by Summer 2017, supporting the previously developed primary school, local centre shops, multi-use village hall, sports pitches and exceptional community play areas.

#### Willow Grove village has seen extensive enabling works (earthworks) completed over 2016 to support the commencement of development in Autumn 2017 including:

- Approximately 1,300 houses
- Large scale open space planting to occur alongside the housing developments
- Construction of the next Primary School / Secondary School (Wixams Academy)
- Willow Grove will have a rural edge defined by fields allowing for more natural open landscapes, with established landscaped edges to provide the setting for early housing
- Initial parcels of land have been sold to Barratt Homes and David Wilson Homes for the construction of circa 1,300 houses
- Willow Grove will be accessed off Southern Cross and Green Lane.

#### Harrowden Green village has progressed with site re-profiling in 2016 and Gallagher Estates are committed to start development in Summer 2017 of the following:

- Approximately 900 houses
- Works to new access onto the B530 are underway
- Residential parcels of land have been sold to Morris Homes and Abbey Homes with the start of the development in Autumn 2017.





Bedford Borough's Local Investment Plan prioritises investment to provide a sustainable infrastructure that promotes economic growth. This investment is critical to Bedford in providing a strong business offer.

## Recent projects in the Borough include:

#### Accelerating Bedford – Fairer and Faster Broadband across Bedford

Local delivery of the national broadband programme is now seeing results on the ground with the project's many local superfast cabinets now live. An extension programme is aiming to get broadband coverage close to 100% of premises. www.bedford.gov.uk/broadband

#### **Bedford Bus Station**

Bedford's long awaited new Bus Station opened at the end of March 2015. The multimillion pound project is one of the largest ever undertaken in Bedford, transforming the face of transport services. The Bus Station area has seen significant improvements including the award winning revamp of



Allhallows car park, new Greyfriars surface car park, environmental improvements including new paving, seating and tree planting as well as enhanced shop fronts and better disabled access.

### **Bedford Western Bypass**

Work on the new road was completed in April 2016 and represents a major development for Bedford, reducing the volume of traffic travelling through the town by completing a route that links all the way from the A421 south of Bedford to the A6 heading north of the town.

### **Bedford High Street THI**

Bedford High Street is seeing the fruits of significant investment from the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF), Bedford Borough Council and Bedford BID, towards the restoration of properties on High Street, as part of the HLF's nationwide Townscape Heritage Initiative ('THI'). The grant funding amounted to a total of £1.95m and generated private sector contributions from landlords and owners of the businesses. bringing the total pot to approx £5m. The main aim is to ensure the long term revitalisation of the historic Bedford High Street area. It focused on 'whole building' schemes, with work on properties including; structural repairs, restoration of traditional shopfronts, reinstatement of lost architectural details and bringing upper floors back into productive use. www.bedford.gov.uk/ bedfordhighstreet

### **Riverside Bedford Development**

Located on the banks of the River Great Ouse this development offers new opportunities for riverside dining or relaxing, new jobs and a major boost for visitor numbers. Most of the tenancies on the site have already been signed up to a string of major entertainment, hotel and restaurant operators. Once completed the site will also include a major new public square and new footbridge linking the site to St Mary's Gardens.

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



The UK is the biggest market in registration terms for Opel Group and fourth largest global market for its parent company, General Motors. The company employs c5.000 people in the UK and exports three quarters of its production. It is headquartered in Luton, where it also manufactures the Vivaro light commercial vehicle and is the largest manufacturer of commercial vehicles in the UK. In addition, Bedfordshire is home to Vauxhall's European Aftersales Warehouse, European OnStar Headquarters, European Customer Contact Centre and Emergency Services Conversion Centre. A second plant at Ellesmere Port in Cheshire produces the Astra and Astra Sports Tourer.
